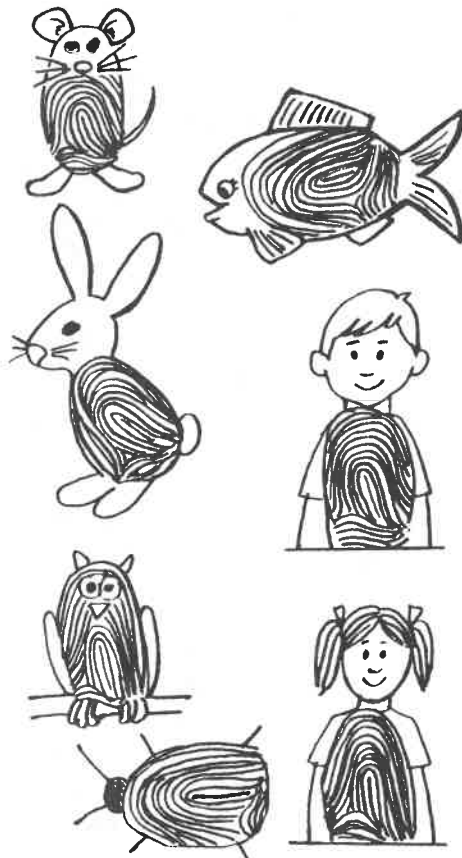
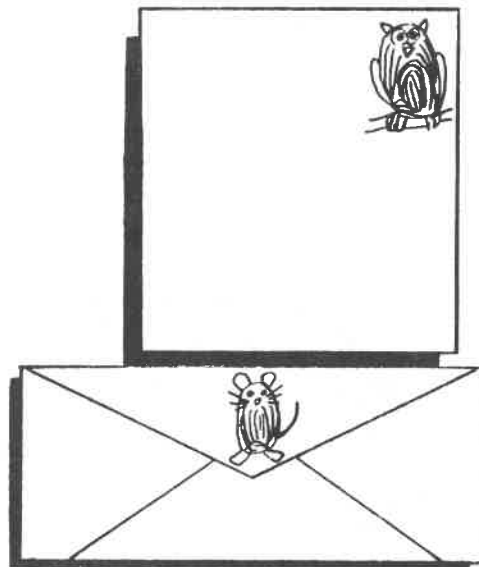




# Creation Stationery



## Evidence

White typing paper  
White envelopes (4½"×9½")  
Washable ink stamp pad or tempera paint (dark colors)  
Fine-point markers

## Clues

*Note:* If you use tempera paint for the fingerprints, premix it to a thick consistency. Use small margarine containers to mix your paint.

1. Invite the students to choose a corner of a piece of paper. Have them place their thumbprint in their chosen corner.
2. Give them fine-point markers and invite them to design an animal or human face and body within their thumbprints. Fish, mice, owls, and ladybugs are but a few possibilities. Encourage the students to design people and animals which God created rather than monsters or other imaginary creatures.
3. Use the fine-point markers to print a Bible verse or other message across the bottom or top of the stationery to share God's love. Suggestions: **God is love. (1 John 4:16)** or **We love because He first loved us. (1 John 4:19)**
4. Make an envelope to match the stationery using the thumbprint creature idea.

## Deductions

Discuss the uniqueness of God's animal and human creations. (See **Genesis 2** and **3**.) Invite the students to write a note on the stationery to witness to God's love for them in Christ Jesus. Send the note to a friend or relative. Purchase stamps so that the students can mail their letters.
