The dates that we will be offering an additional 10:30 worship service will be, Sept. 24, Oct. 29 and Nov. 19. Please put these dates on your calendar if this later

worship time is important to you. We will be polling the people who attend this worship service to help with further decision making. After the November worship, we will revisit the idea as a committee to compile what we have learned during this trial run and make a decision moving forward. Remember the worship dates and
